Anglican Network Church of Canada is in partnership with International China Concern (ICC) to serve together to fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus Christ by being Jesus' hands and feet to bring love, hope and opportunity to the abandoned and disabled children living in a welfare centre in Sanmenxia, Henan Province, China between July 16-31, 2013.

WHO CAN APPLY?

You can apply if you want to be the hands and feet of Jesus to China's abandoned and disabled and have a willing heart to serve them. No special skills or qualifications are required to provide love and care.

Normally ICC only accepts applicants of age 18 or above. However, it has allowed teenagers or younger children who were accompanied by responsible adults going to their mission fields.

If your application is successful, you will be provided with full details of what to expect.

"They had no male role models. We were father figures or big brothers to these boys."

WHAT WILL MY TEAM DO?

The team will meet in Beijing first then travel to Sanmenxia together. When you are at Samenxia Welfare Centre, you will serve alongside the workers there to serve the

abandoned and disabled and to help in a variety of activities. This may involve playing games, assisting with handicrafts, or simply providing comfort and care to a child.

If you have specialist skills in areas such as Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy, Art Therapy, etc., you may have the opportunity to carry out more specialised activities.

Your team schedule will allow for time with the children, as well as time for personal reflection, team building, prayer and worship.

FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

Almost all the meals will be prepared from local, fresh ingredients. Meals usually consist of a variety of vegetable dishes, meat dishes and rice. Specific diet meals can be arranged upon prior request.

Accommodation is in western-style hotels, which are clean and comfortable. All rooms have full bathroom en suite.

The Sanmenxia Welfare Centre is the main care facility within a large geographical area, with children coming from all over Henan Province and the neighbouring provinces of Shanxi and Shaanxi.
