Position:

The successful candidate will be responsible for the following areas:

1. To teach, equip and strengthen parents so they may raise their children according to scriptural principles.
2. To train, equip and coach child and family programme volunteers and staff to create and maintain a balanced and effective ministry.
3. To design a unique ministry plan for each church plant and parish in order that each may build up its own sustainable children's and families ministries.
4. To develop a children's ministry resource bank of materials and curricula.
5. To offer training, coaching and assistance to the children ministries at Good Shepherd Vancouver as a model and resource for AMMiC and the diocese of the Anglican Network in Canada.

Qualifications:

AMMiC is seeking applications from candidates who:

- have theological training from an accredited seminary in children and family ministry.
- have a passion for ministry to children and families.
- have skill and experience in providing training and coaching for children ministries.
- have a demonstrated ability to train church leaders for children-family ministry in a multicultural setting.
- are fluent and comfortable working in English. Knowledge of one or more minority languages (e.g. Chinese or Urdu) is an asset.
- have an understanding of the Asian and African immigrant experience in Canada.
- are willing to work within an Anglican context and structure, and can build a productive working relationship with the Bishop of AMMiC and the clergy and leaders of AMMiC parishes and church plants.
