The Vision of AMMiC

AMMiC is primarily set up to outreaching the visible minorities in Canada. We envision **PLANTING** churches amongst the visible minorities, **STRENGTHENING** them through family-oriented ministries, and **CULTIVATING** collaborative leadership between generations.

The Thanksgiving and Annual Fundraising Dinner is a way that we can all come together to give thanks to our Lord, sharing all the great things that He has done through AMMiC in the past year.

The Fundraising Dinner is the primary channel of revenue for AMMiC to fund church plants and planters, fund ministry projects, and pay staff of AMMiC. Today AMMiC has church plants for the Chinese, Filipino, South Asian, Sudanese, Japanese, and a Cantonese-speaking church plant in Boston, MA. Like the widow’s jar and jug from which endless supply sustained Elijah, AMMiC continues to experience the same miraculous supply from God year after year. The fundraising appeal for July 2019 to June 2020 is \$150,000.
